Rubbish

As per your Lease and Tenancy Agreement chutes should only be used between 8.00am and 8.00pm and not banged closed to reduce disturbance to your neighbours.

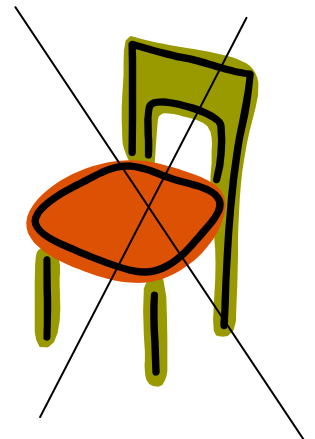
We would like to remind residents that the chutes are for small items of rubbish, preferably in carrier bag sized bags. Anything larger will block the chutes.

The clearing of the chutes is expensive and is charged on top of our estate cleaning costs. Spending on clearing the chutes means that we are using Co-op funds that could be used for other essential works.

Unwanted items of furniture or white goods should be reported to Southwark Council on 020 7525 2000 who will remove them for free.

You should also encourage any contractors or suppliers to take their waste or large unwanted items away with them.

Please try to make use of the re-cycling facilities on the ground floors for cardboard boxes and ensure that bulky items large plastic bags and black bags are taken down stairs to be put into the eurobins not left on the floors. Anyone caught throwing rubbish out of the window will be prosecuted.
